We hope that you and your family are doing well and we wish to thank you for the patience and understanding you've demonstrated as we navigate this situation together!

On behalf of our entire team, we want to say how much we miss your children, and look forward to seeing them again soon. Unfortunately, no one can predict when that will be, or when we'll be able to resume activities at our child care centres.

This is a stressful time and it's important for you to know that our Board and Team understand how our families have been impacted by the unprecedented situation.

Effective immediately we are suspending your child care fees with no loss of spots for families.

We have also made the decision to refund 50% of your fees for the month of March.

Please note: those families receiving subsidy for March fees will receive a fee adjustment upon receipt of subsidy payment. This ensures an accurate calculation of fees after subsidy. The government has stated that subsidy will be paid for hours of care that the child attended which will result in a calculation other than full-time subsidy.

Please know that our educators are like our family; we are currently seeking answers from the Federal and Provincial governments to ensure their financial well-being.

As well, to make things a little easier for families still challenged finding child care for their little ones, our **Family Day Homes** have limited space availability, but we would like to provide care where possible.
